Gaganyaan: The Celestial Vehicle

The Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) is all set to achieve yet another milestone in its space ventures. India's first manned mission 'Gaganyaan' which means 'Celestial Vehicle' is slated for launch by the end of 2024. It aims to schlep a crew of four astronauts into Low Earth Orbit (LEO) of 400 km on a three day mission and bring them back safely to Earth by landing in Indian sea waters. LEO engirdles Earth-centered orbits with an altitude of 2,000 km or less. LEO is considered to be the area in Earth's orbit close to Earth for convenient transportation, communication, the observation and resupply. This is the area where the International Space Station currently orbits. India's heaviest space launch vehicle Launch Vehicle Mark III (LVM3) which was previously known as Geosynchronous Satellite will be the launch vehicle for the Gaganyaan mission. It will consist of three stages - solid stage, liquid stage and cryogenic stage. All systems in the LVM3 launch vehicle are reconfigured especially for the Gaganyaan mission to meet the human requirements and it has been renamed as Human Rated LVM3. HLVM3 will be capable of launching the Orbital Module to an intended Low Earth Orbit of 400 km according to ISRO. This unaided mission will make India the fourth nation in the world after the United States, Russia and China to independently send humans into space. As Prime Minister Narendra Modi puts it "Gaganyaan will be a historic achievement for India in the 21st Century."



शिक्षा का पुनर्जागरण

शिक्षा का मतलब सिर्फ पढ़ाना नहीं बल्कि हमें बच्चों को आने वाली सभी चुनौतियों से सामना करना सिखाना होता है। शिक्षा सिर्फ किताबों तक सीमित नहीं रहनी चाहिए बल्कि अपने चारों ओर से शिक्षा प्राप्त कर बच्चों को स्वावलंबी और बेहतर नागरिक बनाने का उद्देश्य होना चाहिए। शिक्षा हमें सिखाती है अपने से बड़ों का आदर करना और पाई गई विद्या का सही इस्तेमाल करना न कि उसका दुरूपयोग करना। शिक्षा का उद्देश्य बच्चों का मनोबल बढ़ाना और हर चीज के लिए जाग्रत करना होता है |

शिक्षा जीवन में बदलाव लाती है, एवं बच्चों में सामाजिक सहयोग, स्वतंत्र सोच और तकनीकी उन्नति की सोच बढ़ाती है। जिससे उनमें सोचने की क्षमता और समस्याओं को चुनौती के रूप में लेना आदि मूल्यों को समझाती है। वर्त्तमान युग में शिक्षकों को अपनी भूमिका में बदलाव करना होगा।क्योंकि आज इंटरनेट के सहयोग से बच्चों को सभी प्रकार की सूचना प्राप्त होने लगी है। सभी को ज्ञात हो चुका है कि आज शिक्षा प्राप्त करने के कई सारे साधन हैं लेकिन एक शिक्षक ही बच्चों का सही मार्ग दर्शन करा सकता है।इसलिए सभी शिक्षकों को सकारात्मक होकर शिक्षा को बच्चों के मन तक पहुँचाने का एक ज़रिया बनना चाहिए।

आज के बच्चे किताबों के ज्ञान तक ही सीमित नही हैं। आज की पीढ़ी के बच्चों को गतिविधियों द्वारा विषय को समझाने का अलग ही अपना अंदाज़ है। इस प्रकार की शिक्षा से बच्चे जल्दी सीखते हैं। जब बच्चे किसी भी गतिविधि को समूह में करते हैं तो इससे उन्हें एकता में अनेकता का भी अनुभव मिलता है। छात्रों की समझ में गहराई आती है और वे अधिक स्थायी रूप से ज्ञान प्राप्त करते हैं। गतिविधियाँ विषय को वास्तविक जीवन के संदर्भ में स्थापित करती हैं, जिससे बच्चों को जीवन में विषय से संबंधित महत्वपूर्ण सीख मिलती है। आज की शिक्षा सिर्फ एक ही तरीके पर निर्भर नहीं होती क्योंकि हर बच्चा अपने आप में अनोखा है। बस हमें उनकी शक्ति को पहचाने की क्षमता होनी चाहिए।



हमारे विद्यालय में इस वर्ष हर कक्षा में रोचक किस्से और कहानियों द्वारा बच्चों में हिंदी भाषा के प्रति रुझान बढ़ाया गया है। अनेक कविताओं के माध्यम से बच्चों की काल्पनिक ऊर्जा तथा रचनात्मक सोच को आगे बढ़ाने का भी प्रयास किया गया है। हिंदी व्याकरण के नियमों को खेल या पहेलियों के रूप में सिखाने के साथ विषय को भी रोचक बनाया गया। इन सभी प्रकार की गतिविधियों के पीछे एक ही लक्ष्य था कि कैसे छात्रों की समझ में गहराई लाएँ जिससे वे अधिक स्थायी रूप से ज्ञान प्राप्त कर सकें। विभिन्न गतिविधियों द्वारा बच्चों को पढ़ने में स्वतंत्रता दी, उनका मनोबल बढ़ाने के लिए प्रशंसा, जरूरत पड़ने पर सहायता और मार्गदर्शन भी प्रदान किया।इन सभी क्रियाकलाप में बच्चों ने रुचिपूर्ण तरीके से कार्य किया और इस तरह विद्यालय में इस वर्ष हिंदी और अन्य विषयों से शिक्षा में रचनात्मकता लाने की भरपूर कोशिश की गई।

SANSKRIT SECTION

माँ सरस्वती

या कुन्देन्दुतुषारहारधवला या शुभ्रवस्त्रावृता या वीणावरदण्डमण्डितकरा या श्वेतपद्मासना | या ब्रह्माच्युतशंकरप्रभृतिभिर्देवैः सदा वन्दिता सा मां पातु सरस्वती भगवती निःशेषजाड्यापहा ||

अर्थ-जो परमेश्वरी भगवती शारदा कुंदपुष्प, चंद्र और बर्फ के हार के समान श्वेत है और श्वेत वस्त्रों से सुशोभित हो रही है जिसके हाथों में वीणा का श्रेष्ठ दंड सुशोभित है,जो श्वेत कमल पर विराजमान है। जिसकी स्तुति सदा ब्रह्मा विष्णु और महेश द्वारा की जाती है। वह परमेश्वरी समस्त दुर्मति को दूर करने वाली माँ सरस्वती ।

प्रत्येक वर्ष माघ महीने के शुक्ल पक्ष की पंचमी तिथि के दिन को सरस्वती पूजा के रूप में मनाया जाता है|विशेष तौर पर यह दिन देवी सरस्वती की जयंती का दिन होता है| वाग्वादिनी, शारदा, शतरूपा, वीणापाणि, वागेश्वरी, भारती, बुद्धिप्रदायिनी देवी सरस्वती की पूजा की जाती है | देवी सरस्वती को शुक्ल वर्ण, श्वेत वस्त्र धारिणी, वीणावादनतत्परा और श्वेत पद्मासना भी कहा गया है| मां सरस्वती के जितने भी नाम हैं, ये सभी उन्हें अपने स्वरूप और विशेषताओं से ही प्राप्त हुए हैं|



सरस्वती हिन्दू धर्म की प्रमुख वैदिक एवं पौराणिक देवियों में से हैं। सनातन धर्म शास्त्रों में दो सरस्वती का वर्णन आता है, एक ब्रह्मा पत्नी सरस्वती एवं एक ब्रह्मा पुत्री तथा विष्णु पत्नी सरस्वती। ब्रह्मा पत्नी सरस्वती मूल प्रकृति से उत्पन्न सतोगुण महाशक्ति एवं प्रमुख त्रिदेवियों में से एक है एवं विष्णु की पत्नी सरस्वती ब्रह्मा के जिव्हा से प्रकट होने के कारण ब्रह्मा की पुत्री मानी जाती है कई शास्त्रों में इन्हें मुरारी वल्लभा (विष्णु पत्नी) कहकर भी संबोधन किया गया है।कहीं-कहीं ब्रह्मा पुत्री सरस्वती को विष्णु पत्नी सरस्वती से संपूर्णतः अलग माना जाता है इस तरह मतान्तर में तीन सरस्वती का भी वर्णन आता है। इसके अन्य पर्याय या नाम हैं वाणी, शारदा, वागेश्वरी, वेदमाता इत्यादि।ये शुक्लवर्ण, शुक्लाम्बरा, वीणा-पुस्तक-धारिणी तथा श्वेतपद्मासना कही गई हैं। इनकी उपासना करने से मूर्ख भी विद्वान् बन सकता है। माघ शुक्ल पंचमी (श्रीपंचमी/बसंतपंचमी) को इनकी विशेष रूप से पूजन करने की परंपरा है। वी भागवत के अनुसार विष्णु पत्नी सरस्वती वैकुण्ठ में निवास करने वाली है एवं पितामह ब्रह्मा की जिह्वा से जन्मी हैं तथा कहीं-कहीं ऐसा भी वर्णन आता है की नित्यगोलोक निवासी श्री कृष्ण भगवान के वंशी के स्वर से प्रकट हुई है। देवी सरस्वती का वर्णन वेदों के मेधा सूक्त में, उपनिषदों, रामायण, महाभारत के अतिरिक्त कालिका पुराण, वृहत्त नंदीकेश्वर पुराण तथा शिव महापुराण, श्रीमद् देवी भागवत पुराण इत्यादि इसके अलावा ब्रह्मवैवर्त पुराण में विष्णु पत्नी सरस्वती का विशेष उल्लेख आया है।

पौराणिक कथा अनुसार सृष्टि के प्रारंभिक काल में पितामह ब्रह्मा ने अपने संकल्प से ब्रह्मांड की तथा उनमें सभी प्रकार के जंघम-स्थावर जैसे पेड़-पौधे, पशु-पक्षी मनुष्यादि योनियों की रचना की लेकिन अपनी सर्जन से वे संतुष्ट नहीं थे, उन्हें लगता था कि कुछ कमी रह गई है जिसके कारण चारों ओर मौन छाया रहता है।



REFLECTIONS ON THE SESSION



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
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
